

Tony's Testimony of Jesus Christ in His Life

Do you ever look deep into your heart for meaning but find only emptiness? The French scientist and philosopher Pascal once said that every man has a God shaped hole in his heart that only He can fill. I would like to tell you how Jesus Christ filled that hole in my heart.

Often I would drink so much that I couldn't even remember what I did the night before. I would wake up feeling terrible and was struggling to pass two of my engineering courses. I knew I should stop drinking. My family loved me and God had blessed me with a good mind and body, yet I was destroying them. On my own willpower, I vowed to stop. But then I began to question what life was all about. If the goal in life was not to party, then what was it??? I searched for possible reasons for my life, but found no answers.

Six months went by, and I still wondered what my purpose in life was. The hole in my heart seemed even bigger. Gradually I began to drink beer and smoke marijuana again. Then one day I decided to go on a journey to visit a friend who lived about 150 miles away. I had a car, but I wanted to hitch hike for fun and adventure.

A man picked me up who was going all the way to the city where my friend lived. He told me later that when he picked me up the Holy Spirit began speaking to his heart to tell me about Jesus Christ!

He asked me if I were to die that moment would I go to heaven or to hell. I said I thought I had done more good than bad so I would go to heaven. But he told me that according to the Bible I would go to hell because I did not *know* Jesus Christ (John 17:3, I John 5:11-13, Acts 4:12, John 14:6).
